 - a) Cancellation by us
$$\frac{\text{Premium} \times \text{number of days of unexpired period of insurance}}{\text{Total number of days for the full period of insurance}}$$
 - b) Cancellation by you
$$\frac{\text{Premium} \times \text{number of days of unexpired period of insurance} \times 80\%}{\text{Total number of days for the full period of insurance}}$$

MSIG’s determination of all matters relating to this Promotion shall be final and conclusive and in the event of any inconsistency between these Promotion Terms and Conditions and any brochures, marketing or promotional materials relating to this Promotion, these Promotion Terms and Conditions shall prevail.
